(LOCAL LAW # I-1984)

SUPERVISOR JAMES BARNETT PROPOSED A LOCAL LAW #I-84. FOR THE 1984 TAX ROLL FOR THE TOWN OF FREMONT FILED IN AUGUST 1984 THE VETERANS EXEMPTION AMOUNT SHALL BE COMPUTED SO THAT THE RATIO OF THE 1984 EXEMPTION TO THE 1984 ASSESSMENT SHALL BE THE SAME AS THE RATIO WHICH EXISTED ON THE 1982 TAX ROLL, THE ROLL THAT IMMEDIATELY PRECEDED REVALUATION. ANY INCREASE IN VALUE BETWEEN THE 1982 AND 1984 ROLLS DUE TO NEW CONSTRUCTION RATHER THAN REVALUATION SHALL BE DEDUCTED BEFORE THE RATIO IS CALCULATED. THIS RECALCULATION SHALL APPLY ONLY TO PROPERTIES FOR WHICH OWNERSHIP IS UNCHANGED FROM THE 1982 to 1984 ROLLS, AND SHALL APPLY ONLY FOR A PERIOD OF ONE YEAR. THIS LAW SHALL BE SUBJECT TO A PERMISSIVE REFERENDUM.

ALTERNATIVE VETERANS EXEMPTION
OPTION TO NOT GRANT EXEMPTION

Local Law for the Town of Fremont

Local Law No. 2 of the year 1984.

A local law in relation to the alternative veterans exemption from real property taxation.

Be it enacted by the Town Board of the Town of Fremont as follows:

Section 1. The purpose of this law is to provide that no exemption from real property taxes shall be granted pursuant to section 458-a of the Real Property Tax Law of the State of New York.

Section 2. Pursuant to the provisions of subdivision 4 of section 458-a of the Real Property Tax Law of the State of New York, no exemption from real property taxes shall be granted pursuant to section 458-a of the Real Property Tax Law for purposes of real property taxes levied for the Town of Fremont.

Section 3. This local law shall take effect immediately upon its filing with the Secretary of State.
