Local Law #I-1971

A special meeting was called by the Supervisor to proceed with Local Law to retain elected Assessors in the Town of Fremont.

All members were present to answer call of roll.

Motion was made by Charles F. Davis, seconded by Carl Akins that Local Law #I,-1971 to provide for the retention of elected Assessors in the Town of Fremont, be it enacted by the Town Board as follows. Sec. 1 pursuant to provisions of Section 1556 of the real Property Tax Law, the three offices of Assessors of the Town of Fremont shall continue, and shall be elected as provided by law in effect immediately prior to the effective date of said Sec. 1556, Sec. 2 this Local Law shall be submitted for the approval of the Electors of the Town of Fremont at a special election to be held in accordance with the provisions of the municipal home rule law, except such election shall be held not later than July 1, 1971 Sec. 3, the Local Law shall become effective on the twentieth day after approval thereof by the electors of the Town of Fremont at the special election specified in Sec. 2 hereof, and after filing and publication as required by said municipal Home Rule Law.

Motion was approved and carried. Motion was made by James Haenisch, seconded by Robert Osborn, that Public Hearing on the proposed Local Law #I, be held on April 14, 1971 at 8:00 P.M.. Motion approved and carried.

Motion was made by Carl Akins, seconded by James Haenisch that special elections be held on April 27, 1971, 11:00 A.M.- 9:00 P.M. E.D.S.T. Motion approved and carried.

Town Clerk authorized to publish Legal Notice (of Proceeding) in Evening Tribune.

Motion was made and carried to adjourn.
