**A LOCAL LAW TO ESTABLISH THE RESIDENCY REQUIREMENTS FOR THE
OFFICE OF TOWN JUSTICE FOR THE TOWN OF FREMONT**

Be it enacted by the Town Board of the Town of Fremont, County of Steuben, State of New York, as follows:

Section I. Title: A local law to establish the residency requirements for the office of elected Town Justice for the Town of Fremont.

Section II. Authority: This local law is adopted pursuant to Municipal Home Rule Law, Section 10[1][ii][a][1] that grants to local governments the authority to enact local laws regarding the qualifications of local officers. Furthermore, this local law recognizes that the State Legislature amended Public Officers Law, §3 adding new subdivisions, including among other subsections sixty (60) and seventy (70) expanding the residency requirements for a Town Justice in the certain Towns, thereby rendering Public Officers Law a special law with respect to residency of Town Justices and other Town officers (See N.Y. Op. Atty. Gen. (Inf.) No. 91-37).

Section III. Supersession: This local law shall supersede Town Law, Section 23(1) in its application to the residency requirement for an elected Town Justice for the Town of Fremont. This local law also authorizes the Town Board, if necessary, to request that the state legislature adopt a special law amending any applicable state statute that would otherwise require any person seeking to hold the office of Town Justice to be an elector of the Town of Fremont.

Section IV. Residency requirements for Town Justice for the Town of Fremont: Any person holding the office of Town Justice of the Town of Fremont need not be a resident nor an elector of the Town of Fremont, provided, however, that such person shall reside within the County of Steuben in the State of New York. Likewise, any person who is currently a town or village justice in Steuben County may be appointed by the town board to fill a vacancy in the office of the Town Justice not inconsistent with any applicable state statute.

Section V. Inconsistency: All other local laws and ordinances of the Town of Fremont that are inconsistent with the provisions of this local law are hereby repealed; provided however, that such repeal shall only be to the extent of such inconsistency and in all other respects this local law shall be in addition to such other local laws or ordinances regulating and governing the subject matter covered by this local law.

Section VI. Savings Clause: If any clause, sentence, paragraph, word, section or part of this local law shall be adjudged by any court of competent jurisdiction to be unconstitutional, illegal or invalid, such judgment shall not affect, impair or invalidate the remainder, thereof, but shall be confined in its operation of the clause, sentence, paragraph, worked section or part thereof directly involved in the controversy in which such judgment shall have been rendered.

Section VII. Effective Date: This local law shall take effect immediately upon its filing in the office of the Secretary of State, as required by Section 27 of the Municipal Home Rule Law.

Such local law was subject to permissive referendum and no valid petition requesting such referendum was filed as of _____ 20____, in accordance with the applicable provisions of law.

* Elective Chief Executive Officer means or includes the chief executive officer of a county elected on a county-wide basis or, if there be none, the chairperson of the county legislative body, the mayor of a city or village, or the supervisor of a town where such officer is vested with the power to approve or veto local laws or ordinances.

5. (City local law concerning Charter revision proposed by petition.)

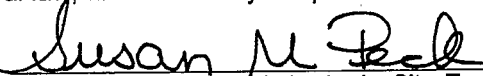

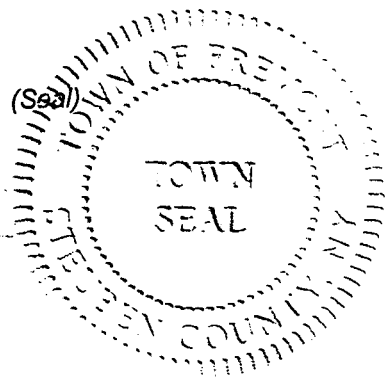
